### Assistant Maths Hub Lead (Primary) post

London South West Maths Hub is seeking to recruit an experienced and highly effective Primary Mastery Specialist Teacher to join our team of Assistant Maths Hub Leads. This is a superb opportunity to work alongside schools across our region, supporting high-quality early mathematics provision and helping to improve outcomes for children, particularly those who need it most.

<b>Job Title:</b>	Primary Assistant Maths Hub Lead for London South West Maths Hub
<b>Information:</b>	This post is for 0.5 day per week (or 20 days per year) and will be confirmed through the application and selection process. The role will work across term time. This post is fixed-term until 31 <sup>st</sup> August 2027 in the first instance, or for the duration of grant funding.
<b>Contract:</b>	Secondment
<b>Start Date:</b>	1 <sup>st</sup> September 2026

#### Background

London South West Maths Hub is one of 40 Department for Education-designated Maths Hubs working together in the national Maths Hub programme, led by two "Outstanding" schools, Chesterton Primary School and Belleville Primary School, our Hub has established a strong track record of high-quality school-to-school support.

Maths Hubs offer professional development opportunities for anyone involved in the teaching of maths, with the aim of driving school-wide change. All activity is led by local school-based teachers and leaders of maths who together form a professional learning community for local leaders of maths education (LLME).

London South West Maths Hub works together with all schools and colleges to support the continuous improvement of mathematics education for all pupils and students in Kingston, Merton, Richmond, Sutton and Wandsworth.

#### The Role

This role is significant in helping shape the vision and direction of the London South West Maths Hub Primary offer. The hub is the go-to place for all mathematics related professional development in the SW London region and benefits from being part of a large national network across England.

The Assistant Maths Hub Lead (Primary) will work alongside the Maths Hub Lead and other Assistant Hub Leads to oversee LLME work, with the following role responsibilities:

##### Leadership and Management Team:

- Work alongside the Maths Hub Lead (MHL) to support implementation of agreed priorities within the Hub strategic plan
- Attend and contribute to Maths Hub Leadership and Management (MHLM) team meetings
- Provide concise updates on Primary activity - highlighting key successes, risks and areas for development.

##### Work Group Oversight:

- Support the planning, monitoring and quality development of Primary Mastery Work Groups
- Maintain regular communication with Work Group Leads and Primary Mastery Specialists (PMS)
- Identify where support or intervention is needed and escalate to the MHL where appropriate
- Contribute to accurate RAG rating and reporting (in collaboration with the Project & Finance Managers).

### **Local Leaders of Mathematics Education (LLME)**

- Contribute to the development of Primary LLMEs, particularly Primary Mastery Specialists
- Support delivery of selected elements of LLME professional development (as agreed with MHL)
- Provide feedback to inform ongoing improvement of the LLME development offer.

### **Communication, Engagement and Recruitment**

- Contribute to promoting Primary Maths Hub activity (e.g. sharing practice, supporting events, input to newsletters)
- Support engagement with schools and leaders to sustain participation in core programmes
- Contribute to Headteacher and school leadership engagement where appropriate
- To work with the wider MHLM team to recruit and retain schools on the core teaching for mastery programmes.

### **Strategic Partnerships**

- Maintain awareness of local context (e.g. through dialogue with stakeholders such as Local Authorities)
- Share relevant insights with the MHL to inform strategic decisions.

### **Systems and Processes**

- Work with the Project Manager to ensure information related to Primary activity is accurate and up to date
- Support processes related to participation, recruitment and reporting.

### **Working with the Maths Hubs Network, NCETM & DfE**

- To attend Primary Assistant Maths Hub Lead (PAMHL) forums as agreed with the MHL.

## **Candidate suitability**

The Assistant Maths Hub Lead will be an outstanding leader who is able to articulate the vision, values and ethos of the London South West Maths Hub and will inspire and empower others to share in achieving them.

They must come from a successful leadership position with previous experience leading a Hub activity and will take responsibility for co-leading the Primary Phase offer within the London South West Maths Hub - overseeing Kingston, Merton, Richmond, Sutton and Wandsworth.

The post will report to the Maths Hub Lead.

## **Time commitment and school expectations**

LLME are seconded from their home school for 20 days (or equivalent to half a day a week) to participate in:

- Maths Hub Leadership team meetings
- continuous professional development
- overseeing Primary LLME activity

Home school headteachers are expected to:

- ensure the mutually agreed release time is provided for the LLME role
- support the LLME to continue developing and embedding mathematics practice within their own school

Schools will be reimbursed for release time.
